BackPAKs. Booster Pak provides food programs for preschool through high school students in the West Des Moines School district. At the end of each week, each student enrolled in the program receives a pack of food that supplements any meals they may not receive at home over the weekend. Students are invited to participate in the program by school officials. Each week, volunteers prepare and deliver packs to each school. A building coordinator or volunteer distributes the food packs to enrolled students. Packs are available in all buildings in West Des Moines Community Schools and serves more than 700 students each week.

PANTRY. Booster Pak also collects and distributes personal care items within the West Des Moines Community Schools.
